UPDATES THAT ADD MAJOR VALUE TO YOUR HOME

CINCO de MAYO PITAYA MARGARITAS



Ingredients

- 4 cups water
- 1½ cups granulated sugar, or to taste
- 1 cup coarsely chopped pitaya (dragon fruit)
- 1/2 cup freshly squeezed lime juice (from about 5 limes)
- lce
- 2 cups tequila blanco
- 2 tablespoons kosher salt, for rimming
- 1 tablespoon crushed dried rose petals, for rimming
- Lime wedges, for rimming

Preparation

1.Combine the water, sugar, pitaya and lime juice in a blender and process until smooth.

2.Transfer to a large pitcher and fill with ice. Add the tequila and stir well with a wooden spoon.

3.Combine the salt and crushed rose petals on a small plate. Moisten the rim of a glass with a lime wedge, then dip the rim in the rose salt. Wiggle the glass to coat the wet part of the rim completely. Repeat to rim the remaining glasses.

4.Fill the glasses with ice, strain the pitaya margarita into them, and serve.

ARE YOU READY FOR A STARTER HOME?

If you're itching for more space or tired of jumping from one apartment to the next and looking to settle down somewhere to plant roots and nest, it could be time to buy.

World Bee Day

Did you know we have World Bee Day? Of course we do, we must because we have appreciation days for National Bubble Wrap Day, Lost Sock Memorial Day and Dance Like a Chicken Day...I'm not making this up. World Bee Day is May 20th and it's the birthday of Anton Janša, a Slovenian, who is credited as the pioneer of beekeeping, back in 1734. It's also now a day to acknowledge the role of bees and other pollinators in the ecosystem.

For the last several years there has been more awareness of the role of bees in our food supply and this year we may see some consequences from the prolonged cold and snowy weather. A recent beekeeping journal noted that the hives that were sent to the almond orchards for pollination did not have the number of bees per hive. As you may recall, a colonies population expands during Spring and Summer. Honeybee hives are contracted in advance to secure availability for pollination, but in addition to the crop being late this year the bees have been slow to ramp up their population so there were fewer bees in the orchards. We'll know later if there were enough bees to successfully pollinate this year's crop. Additionally, due to the delay with almonds, other orchard crops may have to adjust their plans for pollination.

Quoting Ramesh Sagili from OSU Honeybee Lab; "based on what I have gathered from our beekeepers in Oregon (who have almond pollination contracts) and a few California beekeepers, colony losses (nationwide) appear to be significantly higher compared to last year, if not catastrophic." Ok, that sounds grim but there are no wimps in agriculture, it's a tough business and they will do everything possible to mitigate the circumstances.

Now that you are aware of how mother nature threw a curve ball to our hard working agriculture industry, consider how it could affect availability and prices. Instead of being angry about it, do something to help. First, please be selective when choosing and applying pesticides and herbicides. Two, grow pollinator friendly and native plants that are naturally resistant to pests and disease...even you can only grow just a few in a pot on your balcony. Three, share your awareness with friends and family and consider taking a farm tour. Four, donate to a pollinator research lab.

Lastly, this year knowing the circumstance I decided to release the new bees that I ordered months ago to go back into the pool. It's possible that the apiary may keep them for honey production which is part of their income. Hopefully when warm weather...consistently warm weather arrives, bees will flourish and apiary populations quickly recover this year. Oh, and Happy World Bee Day!

Events & Traditions

MOTHER'S DAY





Early Mother's Day celebrations can be dated back to the spring celebrations to honor Rhea, the Mother of the Gods, in ancient Greek civilization, according to some sources. Later, **Mothering Sunday** in the United Kingdom was traditionally a day for people to visit the church where they were baptized, although it now also celebrates motherhood in modern times.

The modern-day origins of Mother's Day can be attributed to two women — Julia Ward Howe and Anna Jarvis, who were important in establishing the tradition in the United States. Around 1870, Julia Ward Howe called for Mother's Day to be celebrated each year. It continued to be held in Boston for about 10 years under her sponsorship, but died out after that. Other sources say that Juliet Calhoun Blakely initiated Mother's Day in Albion, Michigan, in the late 1800s. Her sons paid tribute to her each year and urged others to honor their mothers.

In 1907, Anna Jarvis held a private Mother's Day celebration in memory of her mother, Ann Jarvis, in Grafton, West Virginia. In 1908, she played a key role in arranging a church service that attracted 407 children and their mothers. A Mother's Day International Association was founded in 1912 to promote the holiday in other countries. Mother's Day has grown increasingly popular since then.

Many people believe that Mother's Day is now largely commercialized, with card companies, flower shops, jewelry stores, gift shops, restaurants, hotels, and department stores advertising promotions and special deals for this event. Anna Jarvis, in her lifetime, unsuccessfully filed a lawsuit to stop the overcommercialization of Mother's Day.
